Lisa Manzini has been a dedicated volunteer in the community of Whistler-Squamish for over a decade. Lisa continuously devotes her time and efforts to sustaining and improving sport and healthy living events in her community.

Going above and beyond her duties as a teacher at Garibaldi Highlands Elementary in Squamish, Lisa organizes the district-wide track and field and volleyball tournaments, as well as extra-curricular sporting events for children in the Whistler-Squamish communities.
